Special Meeting with Sheriff Dunn regarding the Osage County Sheriff Dept taking over Police Duties in Carbondale.

Sheriff Dunn was asked to speak to the council about options the Sheriff Dept could offer

1. No city regulations would be enforced by the Sheriff's Dept.- unless it was a dangerous situation.
2. No animal control would be enforced.- unless a dangerous situation
3. All tickets would be municipal tickets and go through City Municipal court- all funds to the city. County ticket funds go to the State.
4. Want access to a local office for the officers
5. Officers would be assigned to the City
6. If the City has equipment that meets their needs, negotiations could be made to include payment for the items.
7. The current City employees could apply for a position with the county if they desire to do so. Sheriff officers for Osage Co are paid \$13.50-\$16.71 per hour with KPERS and BCBS health insurance
8. The current Police Dept building could be rented to the county.
9. Contact Sheriff Dunn with any problems that would arise- employees are Osage Co employees.
10. If someone is at training a replacement would be provided.
11. Fee charged would include all expenses.

Sheriff Dunn needs to know how many officers and how many hours coverage the City wants. She would work with the city for scheduling.
