

IMPORTANT INFORMATION ABOUT YOUR DRINKING WATER
Monitoring Requirements Not Met for City of Carbondale, KS

Our water system violated drinking water standards over the past year. Even though these were not emergencies, as our customers, you have a right to know what happened and what we did to correct these situations.

We are required to monitor your drinking water for specific contaminants on a regular basis. Results of regular monitoring are an indicator of whether our drinking water meets health standards. During the First Quarter of 2018 we did not monitor for Atrazine and therefore cannot be sure of the quality of our drinking water during that time. Even though this was not an emergency, as our customers, you have a right to know what happened and what we did to correct the situation.

What should I do?

There is nothing you need to do at this time.

The table below shows when we did or did not properly collect quarterly samples for Atrazine from January 1, 2018 to March 31, 2019, and when the next sample for Atrazine is scheduled to be taken.
