**2020 CONTRACT FOR STREET REPAIR and MICRO SEAL.**

The City has the right to accept or reject all bids.

1. The purpose of this contract is to obtain bids to overlay streets and micro seal other streets. The bids must be in the City Office no later than April 20, 2020 at 12:00 p.m. The bids will be opened at the regular council meeting April 20, 2020 at 7:00 p.m.  
**(if milling down streets)** The City **will** request that all millings be retained by the City and dumped at the City West lake for City use.
2. **The bid for the following shall be cost per square yard.**
  - Overlay-leveling of all area with a 2" compacted lift and a ¼" crown per foot from center of street unless otherwise stated.
  - Radius are to be included in bid
  - Potholes should be filled before overlay and 1 leveling course as needed.

**2a. Asphalt is to be tapered to each drive way.**
3. If any yard area, drainage area, driveway or any private or City owned property is disturbed in any way, the property must be put back to original form and insure proper drainage is in place by this company.
4. Asphalt must be cleaned up out of drainage ditches and yards. No piles of loose or hardened asphalt is to be left on City or private property for individuals to clean up. No drainage ditch or culvert is to be block by any asphalt.
5. **It is the company's responsibility to do the following:**
  - a) **each company representative must meet personally with the maintenance department representative to ensure your company and the city agrees and understands what is being bid. (no bids will be accepted from companies that do not meet with the maintenance department.)**
  - b) **each company representative must measure areas including radius to ensure proper measurements were given for bidding.**
6. The City manhole lids and water shut off valves are not to be covered with any form of material. The City will be responsible for raising these to the new street level.
7. Payment will be made upon receipt of invoice following completion of work and signed approval sheet from the City Maintenance Department, Council and Mayor.
8. The City maintains the right to have the asphalt inspected by an independent outside

source.

9. Time is of the essence. The Contractor shall begin work no later than June 1, 2020. If contractor cannot start on or before June 1, 2020, please specify a start date as close to June 1, 2020 as possible for consideration. Alternative start date\_\_\_\_\_.

10. If the Contractor fails to start within 15 days of date listed in #9, the City will charge a \$500 late-start penalty fee against Contractor's payment under this agreement.

11. The contract shall be completed within 90 days of date listed in #9, weather permitting. City will monitor the work effort to ensure compliance with all aspects of this contract.

12. All bidders must include a copy of a certificate of liability insurance issued by a corporation authorized to do business within the State of Kansas within minimum limits of \$1,000,000 liability limit for bodily injury from any one accident occurrence and \$1,000,000 property damage insurance and a bid bond.

Such policy shall not contain any deductible provision for more than \$250 and such policy shall not be cancelled or terminated until at least 10 days after a notice of cancellation of the insurance policy is received by the City Clerk from the applicant.
